

You can now specify a BOM number in the Kit/BOM field when entering an order detail for a Bill of Material.

Set up company colours



If you use Sage 300 to manage multiple companies, you can now assign a unique colour to each company to make it easier to differentiate and avoid data entry errors on your web screens. This feature was previously only available in the Desktop application.
